**WHO** is this service for?

The Commercial Recycling program is for businesses, offices, and schools in Fairfield County.

**WHEN** will recyclables be picked up?

Our pick up times vary according to your location and materials generated. Recyclables should be at their designated pick up location by 7:00 AM on the day they are scheduled to be collected. *If you need special arrangements, please contact us so we can instruct our driver of your needs.*

**2010 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

Collection for Commercial Recycling customers will be adjusted for the following Holidays:

**New Year's Day 2010** – The Recycling Center will be closed Friday, January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 in observance of the Holiday. Customers normally serviced on Friday will be serviced Tuesday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

**Thanksgiving Week** – The Recycling Center will be closed Thursday, November 25<sup>th</sup> and Friday, November 26<sup>th</sup> in observance of the Holiday. Customers normally serviced Thursdays will be serviced Wednesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>. Customers normally serviced Fridays will be serviced Tuesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Christmas** – The Recycling Center will be closed Friday, December 24<sup>th</sup> in observance of the Holiday. Customers normally serviced Fridays will be serviced Tuesday, December 21<sup>st</sup>.

**New Year's Day 2011** – The Recycling Center will be closed Friday, December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010 in observance of the Holiday. Customers normally serviced Fridays will be serviced Tuesday, December 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

**HOW** are recyclables prepared for pick up?

**Aluminum Cans:** Please empty all liquids and place in rolling tote or green container

**Steel Cans:** Please empty, rinse and place in rolling tote or green container

**Plastic #1 & #2:** Please empty all liquids and place in rolling tote or green container

**Office Paper, Magazines, Paperboard etc.:** Place in rolling tote or green container

**Corrugated Cardboard:** Please flatten and stack or bundle and place in rolling tote or green container. If you have bales of corrugated, please contact us and we will make arrangements to pick up bales

**Printer Ink Cartridges:** Call ahead for special arrangements for pick up to avoid being damaged by compactor truck

**WHAT** materials cannot be recycled?

- Paper with a heavy wax coating
- Plastics other than #1 & #2
- Plastic peanut butter containers
- Plastic antifreeze and motor oil containers
- Medicine containers (pill bottles)
- Plastic toys
- Aluminum foil and food trays
- Styrofoam of any kind
