

Prescription Drug and Electronics Collection

Saturday, September 25, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

To help curtail existing drug problems and some of the resulting water quality issues we are currently facing in Fairfield County, the Fairfield Soil and Water Conservation District is partnering with the Lancaster Fairfield County Litter Prevention and Recycling Program, Violet Township, and Fairfield County Sheriff's office to sponsor a prescription drug and electronics collection on **Saturday, September 25, 2010** from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

The collection site will be at the Violet Township maintenance garage at 490 N. Center Street in Pickerington, the corner of Stemen Road.

Prescription drug collection will include the following:

Prescription pills, capsules, liquids, creams, gels, ointments, patches, suppositories, powders, syringes, and IVs, will be collected.

No aerosols or inhalers.

You can black out the name or remove the label before coming. If you have something of unknown origin, you may dispose of it, no questions asked. Call the Fairfield SWCD office at (740) 653-8154 with drug questions.

Electronic collection will include the following:

Computers, printers, cables, keyboards and mouse, discs, electronic clocks, VCRs, DVDs, Radios and Cell Phones.
